<Prayer for Reconciliation >

1. Pray for Reconciliation for one another

[Romans 5:10-11 ; 2 Corinthians 5:19](#)

Father God, we thank You for reconciling us to Yourself, through Your Son. We ask You to help us to reconcile with one another. We pray that Your grace would be upon us to be ministers of reconciliation. Fill our hearts with mercy and love for one another. We pray for the power to overcome bitterness, jealousy, envy, and strife. 2. Pray for restoration of homes and parental relationship
